Onondaga County, New York

Manlius and Pompey Towns, 1790-1820

The purpose of this guide is to identify research sources before 1820 in Onondaga County, New York with a focus on Manilus and Pompey Towns.

If a digital source exists, I've omitted references to archival or microfilmed copies.

Historical Background

- 1772 Tryon County created from Albany County, 12 Mar.
- 1784 Renamed Montgomery County, 2 Apr.
- 1790 Pompey Town formed, July 3.
- 1791 Revolutionary soldiers drew for lots on Military tract, 1 Jan.
- 1791 Lost to creation of Herkimer, Otsego and Tioga, 16 Feb.
- 1794 Onondaga County created from Herkimer and Tioga, 5 Mar.
- 1799 Cayuga County created from Onondaga, 8 Mar.
- 1808 Cortland County created from Onondaga, 8 Apr.
- 1816 Oswego County created from Onondaga, 1 Mar.
- 1828 Onondaga and Cayuga exchanged land establishing current boundaries.

Census Records

- The earliest federal census for Onondaga County is 1800. In 1790, Onondaga County was part of Montgomery County, New York. Index and images available at Ancestry.com.
- New York State censuses for 1825, 1835, and 1845 do not survive for Onondaga County.
- Manlius was incorrectly microfilmed in 1820 and appears in neighboring Cicero Town. See <u>American Pomeroy Historic Genealogical Association</u> web site for a corrected index.

Probate Records

Probate records including original estates and wills for New York are held in the office of the <u>Onondaga</u> <u>County, New York County Surrogate Court</u> beginning in 1787, or when the county was formed. Prior to 1787, most are housed at the <u>New York State Archives</u>.




